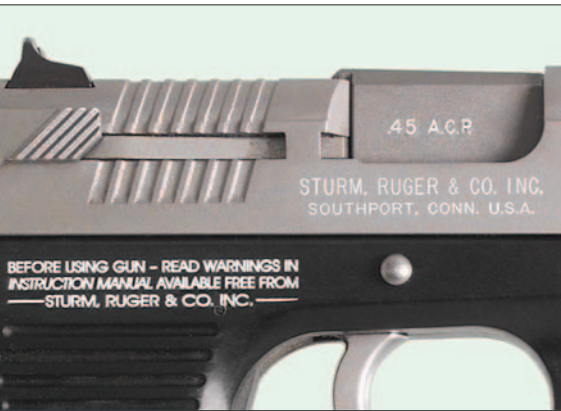

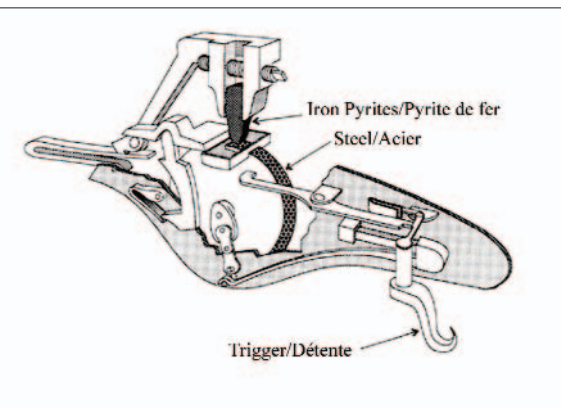

What does it do?
