

NIBIN REOPENS CLUB RUM CASE: A NASSAU COUNTY STORY



Nassau County Police Officers responded to a shooting between gang members at Claridge Avenue and Blackstone Street, in Elmont, N.Y.

Investigators obtained statements and arrested three shooters a short time later.

A crime scene search turned up many expended cartridge casings as evidence.

The evidence was searched against the NIBIN database using the Nassau County IBIS system.

The NIBIN search allowed forensic experts to link the evidence from the Claridge Avenue shooting to a shooting that occurred three days before at the Club Rum Bar, on Hempstead Turnpike.



At Club Rum, a man had been shot but detectives at that time had no leads to pursue and the case went cold very quickly.

The NIBIN links provided Club Rum investigators with new leads in the form of prime suspects from the Claridge Avenue case.
